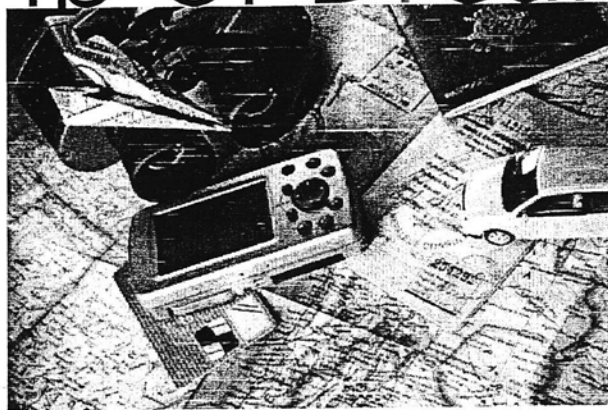

amount of money you have been allotted, you will have to spend some time on Saturdays to do work until your bill has been paid in full.



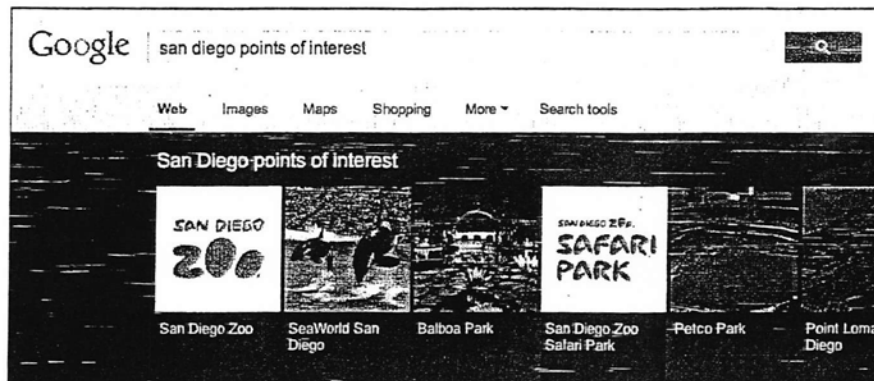
TIPS for Planning YOUR Trip:
